November 2, 2017 Board of Education Meeting

### **PVC Principal Search**

Dr. Fuhrman reviewed the district's process for conducting an administrator search and informed the Board of Education that the outreach for a new middle school principal will begin in January, 2018. A search process outline will be posted to the Superintendent's page on the district website. At this stage, the public is invited to share their thinking by emailing Dr. Fuhrman and/or the Board of Education.

### **Superintendent Search**

On Tuesday, November 7, 2017 at 7 pm, in the Community Room at Croton-Harmon High School, PNW BOCES will present the Superintendent Search survey and forum results to the Board of Education and will also identify the next steps in the process. The session will be videotaped and posted under the district's website tab, "Superintendent Search."

### **Lunch Program**

The lunch program has begun at Croton-Harmon High School and has approximately 50 daily customers. Light breakfast options have been particularly well-received by students. Three commissaries now act as vendors for the program. The Board of Education will continue to review the recommendations put forth by the Lunch Committee for further development of the program at its November 16th work session.
