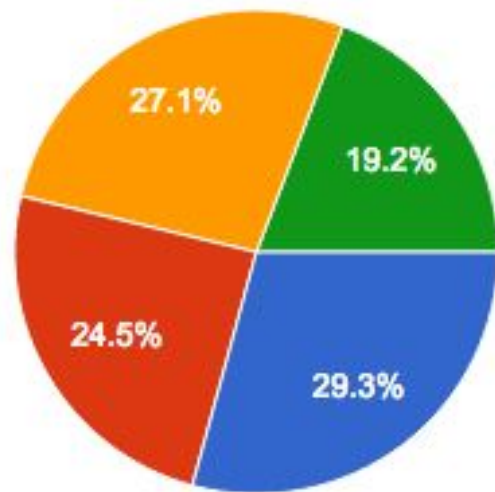

# Survey Info

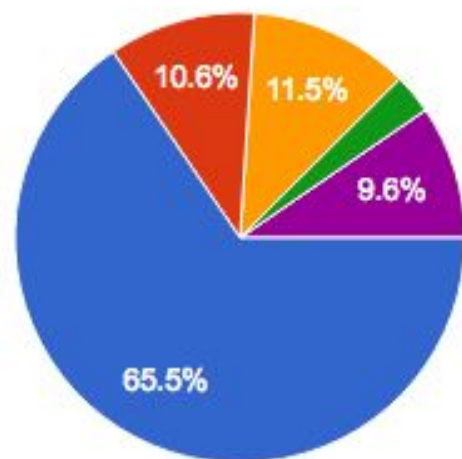
- Description given to students:

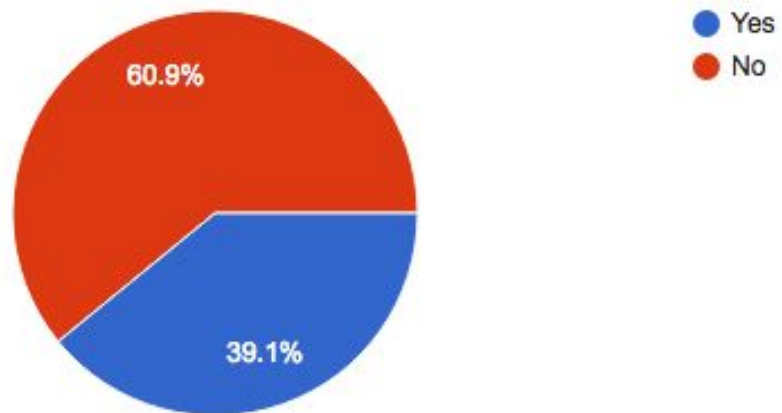
## When you leave campus, where do you get your lunch? (417 responses)

- I don't (or only very rarely) leave campus for lunch

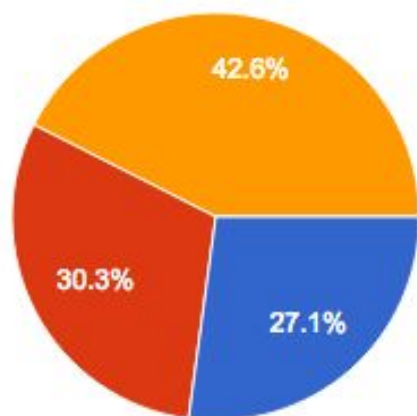
Do you sometimes leave school for lunch because there isn't space to sit and eat?

(417 responses)



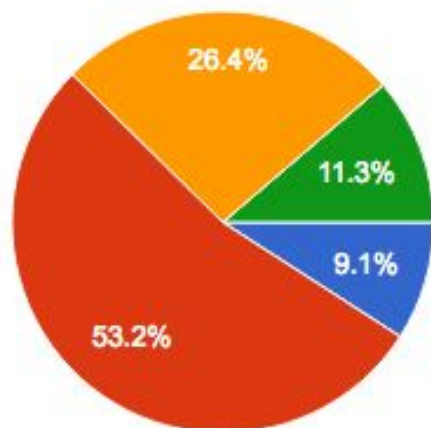
## Just to make sure we've got you right: On average, how often do you leave campus during your lunch period (even if you come back)?

(188 responses)



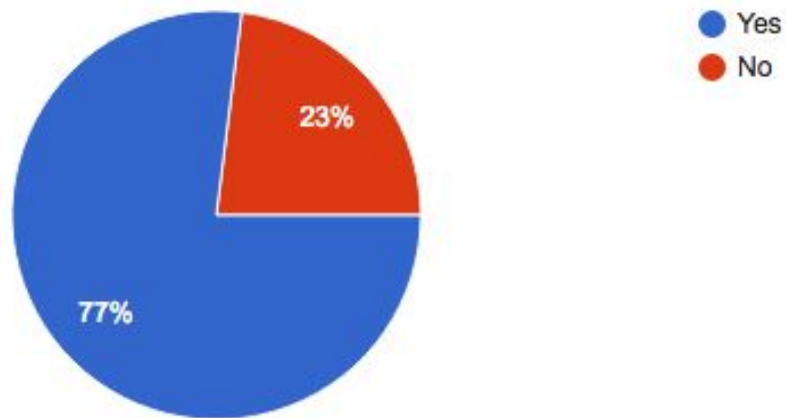
- 0-1 days per week (I rarely leave)

- I never (or almost never) purchase lunch in town, so I'm not sure.

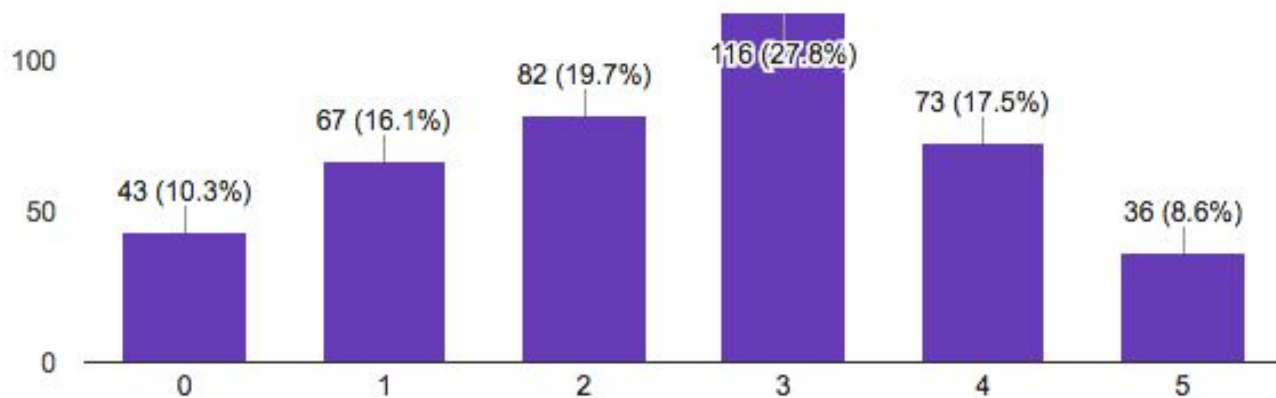
Would a less expensive (quality) lunch be appealing to you? (417 responses)





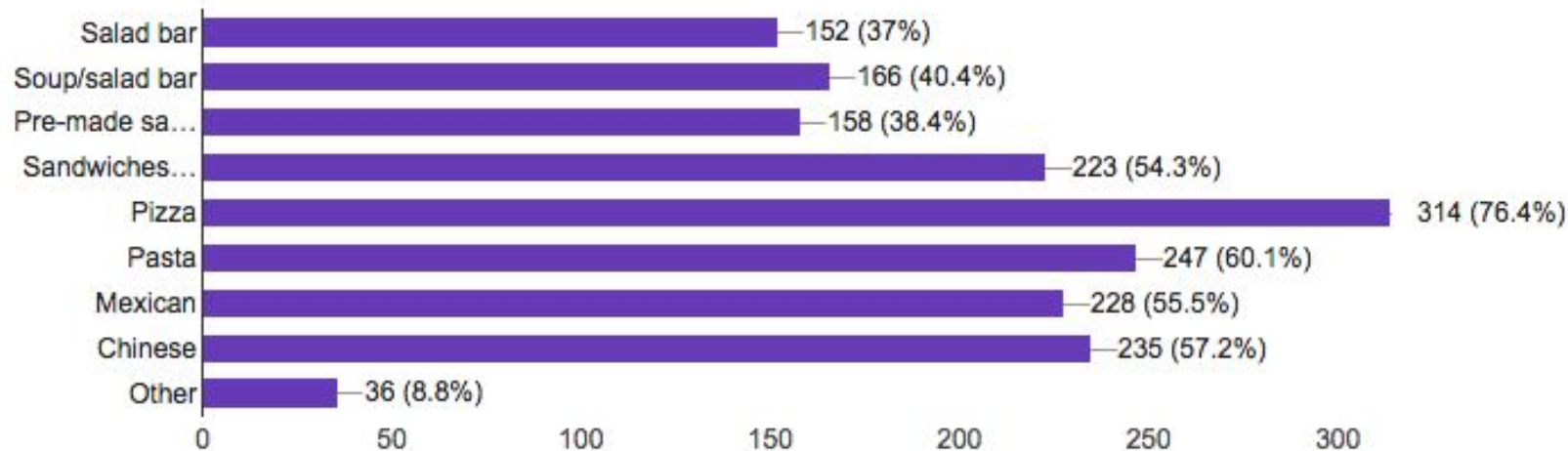
If there were a lunch program in the school, do you think you would participate (you could still choose to go home or go to town if you wanted)?
