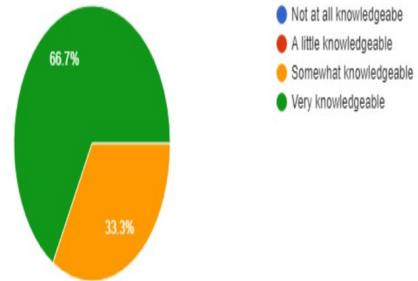
How satisfied are you with each of the following?
