Sexual Assault: An Honest Conversation Based Upon Real-Life Cases

This presentation designed for high school students, parents and school staff addresses the topic of sexual assault using real-life cases from our County. This is an interactive, thought-provoking and candid workshop intended to heighten the students' awareness of sexual assault cases in the following areas: lack of consent, the use of technology, statutory crimes and alcohol use and abuse. It is the hope that this presentation will help male and female students become more cognizant of the dangers that lurk in society, and while we aim for prevention, we recognize that anyone, can become the victim of a sexual assault. Therefore, this presentation will provide pertinent information to students regarding what steps to take should they be victimized. This PowerPoint presentation is designed for large groups but can be tailored to an individual classroom.

Teen Dating Violence

This presentation designed for **high school students** addresses the issue of emotional, physical and sexual abuse in the context of teen dating relationships. Students are educated on the signs of dating abuse, bystander intervention and the impact of teen dating violence on its victims. During the presentation, prosecutors present students with various scenarios to engage them in a discussion on the topic. This presentation can also be tailored to **parents and school staff**, focusing on identifying the signs of teen dating abuse and how to talk to teen victims.
