



Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), is a federal law created to protect children's privacy on the internet. Croton-Harmon UFSD utilizes several computer software applications and web-based services to provide your child with the most effective web-based tools and applications for learning. These programs and services are not operated by Croton-Harmon UFSD, but by third parties. These resources include (but are not limited to) Achieve 3000, Newsela, Tinkercad, WeVideo and similar educational programs. A list of the programs utilized by the district with the privacy policy for each can be found on the school website in the Privacy section of the Technology page <https://dpit.riconedpss.org/billofrights/02d9d2af98c045c403f0>). Please note this list is periodically updated as applications and web based services are added to our curriculum throughout the year.

In order for our students to use these programs and services, certain personal identifying information, generally the student's name and email address, must be provided to the web site operator. Under federal law, these websites must provide parental notification and obtain parental consent before collecting personal information from children under the age of 13.

The law permits schools such as Croton-Harmon UFSD to consent to the collection of personal information on behalf of its students, where the personal information collected is for the use and benefit of the District, and for no other commercial purpose.

This form will constitute consent for Croton-Harmon UFSD to provide personal identifying information for your child consisting of first name, last name, email address and username to the web-operators listed on our website at <https://dpit.riconedpss.org/billofrights/02d9d2af98c045c403f0> and to the operators of any additional web-based educational programs and services which the District may add during the upcoming academic year. The personal information collected is exclusively for the use and benefit of the District.
