

Information about Attendance at District Events
March 10, 2020



Dear Croton-Harmon Families,

With the growing number of coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Westchester County, the District has taken numerous measures to ensure the safety of our schools for students, parents and staff members. This includes, but is not limited to, increased cleaning, disinfecting and sanitizing in each of our schools and all of our facilities and grounds, as well as the cancelling of field trips and the District's participation in various events outside of the District. However, at this time, there has been no decision to cancel all in-District events, presentations and/or performances. The District will evaluate such events, presentations and/or performances on a case by case basis and, for now, will make individual determinations as to any cancellations, if prudent and/or necessary.

The District believes it is important to maintain such events, presentations and/or performances where possible, to provide continuity of instruction and to enrich the learning experiences of our students, as well as to ensure that our students get to realize the results of their own hard work and dedication as it pertains to student performances.

To ensure that the District can continue to hold such events, presentations and/or performances for the benefit of our students, we ask that you assist us by doing the following:

- If you have recently traveled abroad, especially to a country that has been impacted by coronavirus, please refrain from visiting our schools or attending any District events, presentations and/or performances if you are still within the two (2) week period of the date of your return from such travels.
- If you are feeling sick, even if only experiencing a mild cold or cough, please refrain from visiting our schools or attending any District events, presentations and/or performances.
- If your child is feeling sick, even if only experiencing a mild cold or cough, please refrain from sending him/her to school as well as from sending him/her to attend any District events, presentations and/or performances.

- If you have been, or believe that you may have been, present in a location that is known or suspected to have had an individual who has either tested positive for coronavirus or is currently under self-quarantine, please refrain from visiting our schools or attending any District events, presentations and/or performances.
- If you have been, or believe that you may have been, in contact with an individual who has either tested positive for coronavirus or is currently under self-quarantine, please refrain from visiting our schools or attending any District events, presentations and/or performances.
- If you have been in contact with a person who is known to have been in contact with an individual who has either tested positive for coronavirus or is currently under self-quarantine (even if that person himself/herself has not tested positive and/or is not currently under self-quarantine), please refrain from visiting our schools or attending any District events, presentations and/or performances.
