**K12 Alert from: April 7, 2020**

Good Morning Croton-Harmon Students, Parents, Staff and Community,

I hope this message finds you and your family doing well. I am writing to share two recent updates provided by Governor Cuomo and the New York State Education Department.

First, Governor Cuomo has extended school closures until April 29. He will reassess the situation at that time to determine if schools will reopen or if the closure should be extended.

Therefore:

- eLearning will continue and students will access their daily instruction remotely. Each day, students will continue to login to the website to access their learning.
- Our meal service continues. Grab and Go lunches are available at PVC. Please contact Tracey Borges ([tracey.borges@chufsd.org](mailto:tracey.borges@chufsd.org)) for pick up schedule times/days.
- Child care continues. Should first responders and health care workers need child care so they can perform their essential duties, contact John Griffiths ([john.griffiths@chufsd.org](mailto:john.griffiths@chufsd.org)).

Second, the New York State Department of Education will be canceling June Regents Exams. We await more information about this and will forward to you when it becomes available.
