Good Evening Croton-Harmon Students, Parents, Staff and Community,

I hope this email finds you and your family doing well. I am writing to inform you that the Board of Education has amended this year's school calendar. As you know, New York State mandates that school districts provide at least 180 days of instruction each school year. Due to the Governor's Executive Order, this year Croton-Harmon continued instruction during spring break and on the Friday before the Memorial Day holiday. Assuming there are no additional Executive Orders from the Governor's Office, **the last day of school for students will be on Friday, June, 19, 2020**. Although this day will mark the end of our school year and our eLearning, we will have several school events that will take place the week of June 22-26. Principals will be sharing end of the year details in separate messages including information about schedules for class meetings during the week of June 8 and June 15 to end our school year.

I have been so impressed with the efforts of our teachers, administrators, staff, parents, community AND especially our students. Our students have demonstrated incredible resilience, flexibility, and empathy throughout these last months. As a district we are already planning for September and have formed a School Reentry Task Force. I will continue to provide updates throughout the summer.
