Student's reports are sent home throughout the year and in some cases discussed with students during conferences with the teacher. It is important to bear in mind the following as you and your child review the assessment scores, as with any assessment:

The STAR score is only a snapshot of a child's reading progress. It is given during one specific time frame, on one day out of the trimester. Varying factors could be responsible for a significant increase or decrease in a score and the best way to monitor a child's progress is through the teachers a child interacts with. The STAR assessment is only one factor in a teacher's monitoring of the whole student.

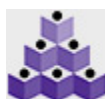
