What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	\$0. Out-of-Network: Individual \$750 / Family \$2,000.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. Emergency care, <u>preventive care</u> , inpatient hospital services, outpatient hospital services & <u>prescription drugs</u> ; plus in-network office visits are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. - Private-duty nursing - Limited to \$400/day.
- Mental Health – Maternal Depression coverage under infant's plan.
- Teladoc – Telemedicine service made available through Aetna for 24 hour, on-demand general medical, dermatology, and behavioral health. Standard \$10 co-pay.

Your Rights to Continue Coverage:

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

Minimum Essential Coverage generally includes plans, health insurance available through the Marketplace or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of Minimum Essential Coverage, you may not be eligible for the premium tax credit.

Does this plan meet Minimum Value Standards? Yes.

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.
